The following request to support library services for the Carson City Library are through four areas:

- Collections
- Community Programming
- Technology
- Grant Matching*

I understand the nature of fundraising through the Friends of the Carson City Library Browser's Corner across the street at 711 E. Washington Street and have made the Library's request here.

*Due to the nature of grant funding and matching requests, the amount requested is an estimate. If awarded these grants and the funding need changes the library will re-request at that time.

January 2019: To be spent January 2019 – December 2019

Community Programming [\$3,000]

Support includes providing funding to support National Library Week, Read by 3 Governor supported programming, and NCLab computer coding camps and workshops.

Summer Learning Challenge [\$3,500]

Materials, prizes and grand prizes for all age groups.

Summer Learning Challenge In-Kind [\$0.00]

Up to 700 Youth books to be used as giveaways from donated items to the Browser's Corner.

Summer Learning Challenge for Boys and Girls Clubs of Western Nevada [\$2,000]

Support for a Summer Learning Challenge program to be run at the Boys and Girls Clubs of Western Nevada, including programs and prizes.

Library Program at Boys and Girls Clubs of Western Nevada [\$5,000]

Support for library staffing at the Boys and Girls Clubs of Western Nevada.

Year-Around Learning Challenge Online Portal [\$2,000]

Matching city funding (05-40), the online portal is designed for all ages of participation, including Adults. Includes the ability to record reading minutes, earn badges, play games, and earn points for reading a book list and attending summer events. Is a yearly subscription site, so it can be used throughout the year for different programs including the community book read during National Library Week.

Teen Leadership Council [\$1,000]

Provides ability for the TLC meetings to have food and plan for other Teen outreach activities throughout the year.

Capital Improvement Project Match [\$5,000]

Matching city funding (06-25), the match will provide 5 new public access computers. This will allow the library to replace at least 10 current computers in FY19.

Total Request as of January: \$21,500

July 2019: To be spent July 2019 – December 2019

Collections [\$24,000]

Ex: Print Book Lease, EBooks, E-Reference, E-Audio Books.

Community Programming [\$3,000]

Support includes providing funding to support Banned Books Week, Hour of Code with Raspberry Pi (December), and community partnerships for Dia de Los Muertos.

Grant Match [\$15,000]

Ex: Matching funds to leverage local and federal funding. This will include NASA @ My Library and Nevada State Library, Archives and Public Records LSTA Grants.

Total Request for July: \$42,000
