- · Little containers of hand sanitizers


The donated supplies benefit children of all school ages, kindergarten through high school.












Social Media Recommendations

Book Face Fridays

 Our recommendation: Continue sharing Book Face Fridays and ask volunteers to send in one in-house Book Face Friday per month and to encourage visitors to participate in the trend by tagging us on Instagram (possibly offer an incentive such as 10% or \$1 off when you participate).

Photos of book store

 Our recommendation: Provide more photos or video of inventory each week or month. RAD will create "This Week at Browsers Corner Book Store/This Month at Browsers Corner" posts

Holiday-related posts

 Our recommendation: On top of photos, send RAD videos of the decorated book store to promote sales throughout the year

Website Traffic

- Unique visitors represented a slight decrease compared to 2021 but an overall increase compared to 2019
- Pageviews represent an increase of 4%



2023 Marketing Suggestions

On top of the marketing services RAD provides, we suggest the following marketing tactics and activities to increase the reach and awareness building within the community:

- Partner with local authors to host book signings or children's book readings in the book store
- Send RAD short videos of the book store, volunteers and customers via text or email
- Invest in a marketing video, possibly in collaboration with the library
- Host a book fair at an elementary school in which FOCCL sells secondhand books and provides information about the local library
- Partner with local schools or colleges to organize opportunities to provide books to the community
- Create punch cards (ex. purchase 10 books and the 11th one is free)
- Partner with a local coffee shop for displays of books for sale
 - For example, ask a local coffee shop to organize a table in their shop with Browsers books for sale in exchange for helping promote their coffee via social media and newsletters
- Set a weekly or monthly budget to boost social posts and reach more people
- Manage and/or setup reviews on Google, Yelp, etc. and ask patrons for store reviews
